• Rapid Interface Builder



- Browser-based design tool for prototyping and UI creation for web applications.
- Layout your UI by dropping widgets onto a canvas.
- Export the generated HTML and Javascript.
- Web Simulator



- Lightweight tool for developing mobile web applications.
- Enables running and debugging web APIs for a variety of mobile platforms.
- Supports the Tizen 1.0 Web API.
- Online functional previews (no installation required)
- Fully open source projects that you can contribute to


### **Open Source Community: What and Who**

- Community includes all of the people who work on or with a project
  - **Product contributors:** kernel / distribution developers, release managers, quality assurance, localization, etc.
  - App developers: writing applications to run on devices
  - **Users**: people who run it on their device and provide feedback
  - Vendors: companies creating products based on the platform
  - **Other contributors**: promotion, moderation, documentation and more

Some people contribute as part of their employment at companies, while others contribute free time. The community includes all of the people who are doing interesting work on these projects.



# **Tizen Community Challenges**

- Interest in Tizen is Low
  - Need consumer devices in the market for people to get excited about
- Lack of Applications
  - Developer devices available tomorrow
  - Continue improvements to SDK (add other OSs)
  - HTML5 development is relatively new
  - Still working on finishing the plan for an app store
- Community / Developer Burnout
  - Asking community to support one more thing



### **Tizen Community Focus: Address Challenges**

- Device Manufacturers / Operators
  - Need to build devices using Tizen
  - Need successful devices in the market that consumers can get excited about
- Application Developers
  - Large application ecosystem needed to be successful
  - Get developers started now while we finish getting the store ready.
- Not ready to focus on end users
  - Nothing for them to use yet

- Write HTML5 apps for Tizen
- Use & contribute to tools like RIB & Web Simulator
- Add documentation to the wiki to help others
- Ask or answer questions on the mailing lists and IRC
- Build products / devices on Tizen
